Systemic barriers, as well as implicit and explicit biases among healthcare teams, contribute to this issue. Addressing these biases and prioritizing the needs of these communities is crucial for delivering high-quality care.

LEARNING

- Explain core concepts related to health equity.
- Use data to identify, prioritize and reduce disparities and improve care delivery.
- Recognize the value and challenges of collecting REAL and SOGI data.
- Design next steps for advancing equity in your organization.
- Recognize intersectionality and its connection to a patient's experience of care.
- Recognize inequities based on gender identity, race, ethnicity or national origin, linguistic needs, physical and intellectual disability, socio-economic, veteran or health status.

GROWTH

- Demonstrate linguistic best practices in policy, process and care delivery.
- Use correct gender pronouns.
- Hold person-centered conversations with all patient AND peers.
- Recognize the impact of health related social needs on patient engagement and outcomes.
- Compare methods to integrate screening for social needs into clinical workflow.
- Adopt skills and tools to ensure patient and caregiver understanding of clinical advice at all levels of health literacy.
- Implement culturally and linguistically appropriate services.
