The MA will typically complete the screenings. All screenings will be discussed in the morning huddle and providers will give the MA assessments based on clinical judgement when needed.

Edinburgh (EPDS)	At first prenatal appointment 26 weeks prenatal 2 weeks postpartum 6 week postpartum Given at every appointment IF patient scores positive during the screening
PHQ9/GAD7	All dads who come in during prenatal or postpartum appointments
PHQ9/GAD7	As needed based on provider's clinical judgement If SBIRT is positive or if patient shares something in session
